

Do you get your prescription drugs from Medicare?

Common drug plans include: Health Net Orange, AARP, Community CCRx Basic, Medco and WellCare

Your current drug plan might change in January 2013.

- ⇒ You might be switched out of your current plan if you don't choose another one.
- ⇒ Your current drug plan might not pay for all of your drugs next year.



You might be able to lower your Medicare prescription drug costs.

- ⇒ Letters about Medicare drug benefits from the Social Security Administration, Medicare agency, District of Columbia government or private drug plan
