Common drug plans include: AARP, Bravo, CVS Caremark, Community Care Rx Basic, Health Net Orange, and WellCare

Your current drug plan might change in January 2013.

- ⇒ You might be switched out of your current plan if you don't choose another one.
- ⇒ Your current drug plan might not pay for all of your drugs next year.

You might be able to lower your Medicare prescription drug costs.
