



DO YOU HAVE DC MEDICAID*, ALLIANCE* OR MEDICARE?

(*This includes AmeriHealth, MedStar, Trusted or Health Services for Children with Special Needs)

Because of health care reform, people without health insurance can sign up for a plan through DC Health Link starting October 1, 2013. So you may be hearing a lot about health care changes these days.

BUT, if you have **DC Medicaid, Alliance, or Medicare**, your benefits **should not change** unless you receive notice from the DC or federal government or DC Health Link.

In fact, your benefits may even get better.

WATCH OUT FOR SCAMMERS

If someone you don't know calls you (or comes to your door) and tells you that you will lose your health care because of the new health care law, **THIS MAY BE A SCAM.**

DO NOT give them money, your Social Security Number, bank account numbers or any other personal information.

Instead, call Legal Aid at 202-628-1161 or come to our offices during our intake hours for help.

You should also call or come to Legal Aid if you have problems with, or get cut off of, DC Medicaid, Alliance or Medicare.
